

P. D. PODGORODETSKY AND RECREATIONAL GEOGRAPHY.

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Examines the role of the well-known physical geographers Tauride University Professor P. D. Podgorodetsky in the formation of recreational geography and the main directions of his research.

P. D. Podgorodetsky was directly involved in the development of new academic elective course "Fundamentals of recreational geography", which in 1974 began to read for students of geography (one of the first in the country), in the preparation of its curriculum, writing a textbook "Physical geography basics of recreational geography ", to attract students to scientific work on the assessment of natural recreational resources for the study of the stability of landscapes to recreational load, on greening tourism in Crimea. In developing the resort and recreation issues P. D. Podgorodetsky engaged mainly study the natural component and make recommendations on the landscape and environmental methodological basis. Developed methodology of the study of the recreational needs of different population groups and the nature of recreational impacts on the environment.

Analysis of works by P. D. Podgorodetsky recreational geographical topics demonstrates the depth of their scientific study and the relevance of many of his tips and tricks, including: in any economic strategies (including recreational) development areas must take into account that the priority must be given to important natural features of landscapes – resource– and environmental-productive functions.
